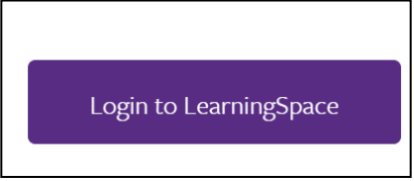
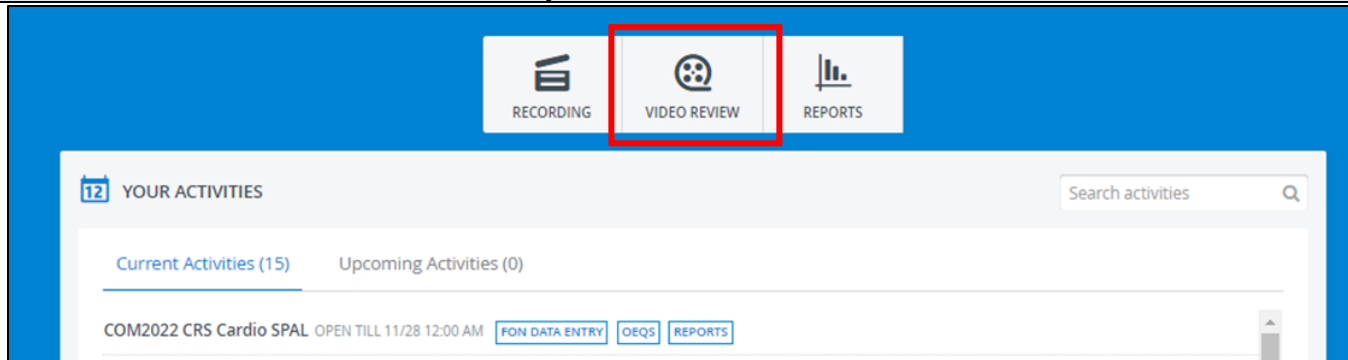


Clinician: How to Find Videos of Your Students In LearningSpace

<p>USE THIS BROWSER If on Personal Computer</p>	<p>Use Chrome browser and go to https://www.dmu.edu/simulation-center/learningspace/</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This will open the Simulation Center Testing Page • Locate the purple LearningSpace button and click on it to take you to the sign-in page 	
<p>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</p>	<p>The checklist is attached to the live recording, or a recorded video. You can watch the video and complete the checklist at the same time, or you can watch and then complete the checklist.</p> <p>If you aren't already, you will be prompted to log into Office 365</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If an internal clinician: Use your DMU credentials [this is not case sensitive] and password [this is case sensitive] <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If you have problems with your DMU credentials- contact DMU ITS • If an external clinician: Use your DMU provided credentials (this will be on a paper at your computer station) [this is not case sensitive and there are no spaces] and password [this is case sensitive] <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If you have problems with logging in let Simulation Center staff know

Open Video Review



On your dashboard, click or tap the **Video Review** icon (outlined in red above).
The list of available videos opens.

To open the video:

1. Find the video in the list.
2. Click or tap anywhere in the row to open the video.
The video opens and begins to play.

Tip: Can't find the video? Search for it.

Videos are identified by:

- Date and time of recording
- Room number
- Student name
- Activity name
- Case name

You can search for a video typing any of these identifiers into the *Quick search* field and then tapping the Enter/Return key on your keyboard.

SP EXAM 6 Camera A

The video plays automatically. Use the video controls at the top of the screen to pause and play the video as needed.

You can identify the video by looking at the Record Control panel, which contains the following information:

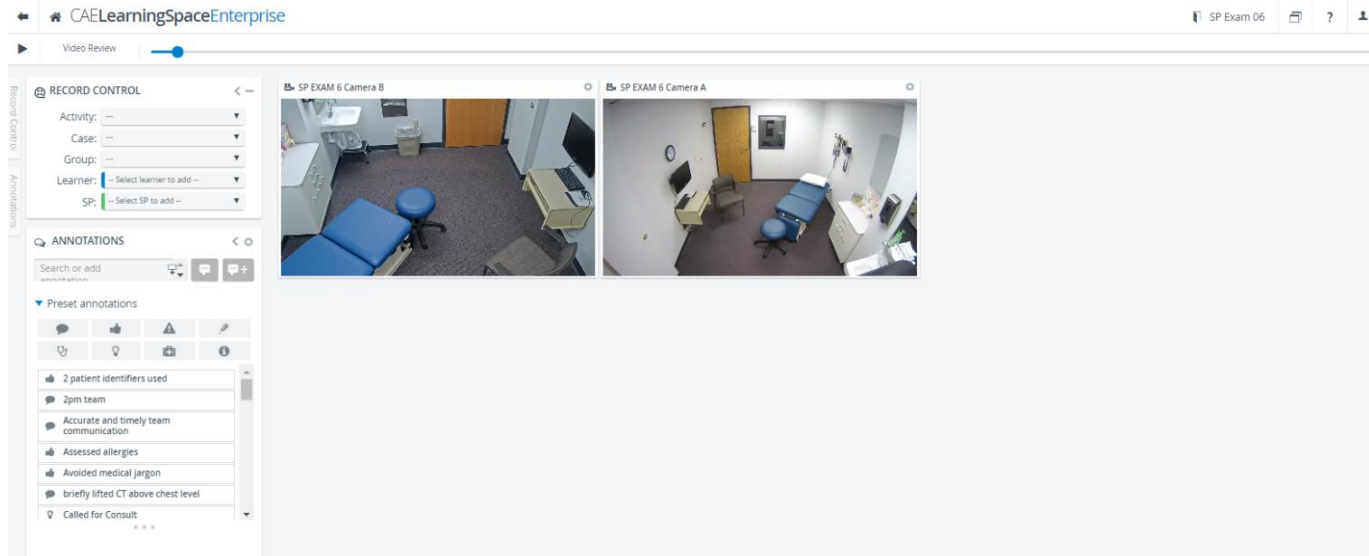
- The Activity
- The Case
- The Learner Group
- The name of the student in the video

The room the video was recorded in is shown above each camera view.


Select another video by clicking or tapping the back arrow (in the upper left corner of the screen) to return to the list of recorded videos.

NOTE: The number of cameras in the room determines the number of videos. You may see more videos than shown here.

Add Comments to Video with Annotations Feature



When the video loads, the Annotations panel pops out automatically. You can add comments to the video using this feature:

1. Type your comment in the **Search or add annotation** box.
2. Click or tap the comment icon () to add the annotation.

OR

Tap the Enter/Return key on your keyboard.

The time-stamped annotation is added to the Annotations panel and a flag is added to the video progress bar.

3. Click the time stamp or the flag to go to that point in the video.

To change the size of a video:

1. Click or tap the cogwheel in the upper right corner of any video window.
2. The Window Control options appear.

Make smaller

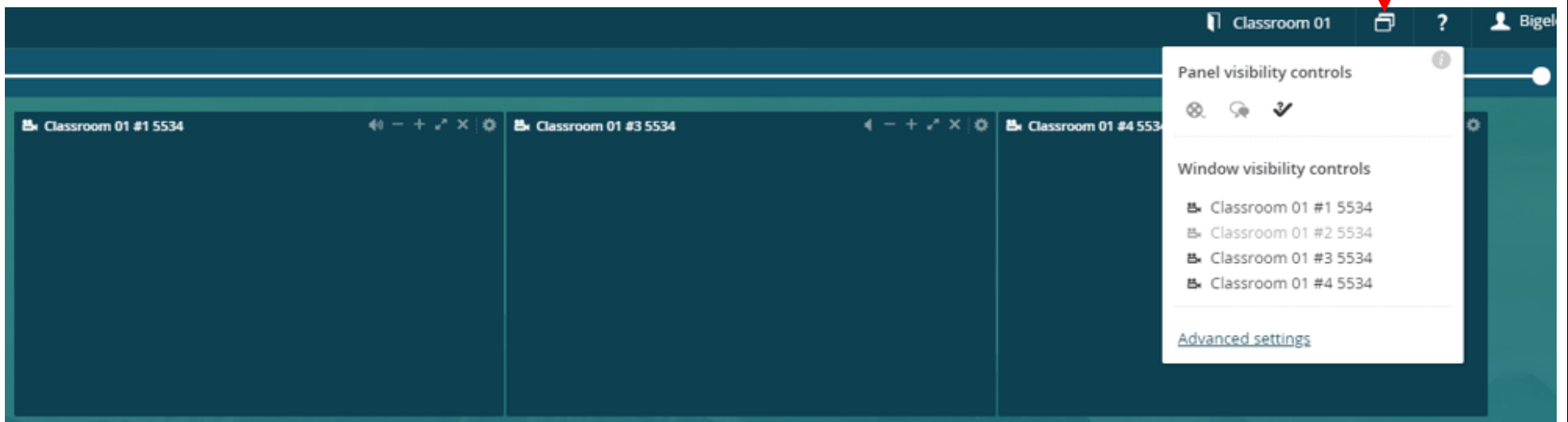
Make larger

Close video

Sound on/off

Make full screen

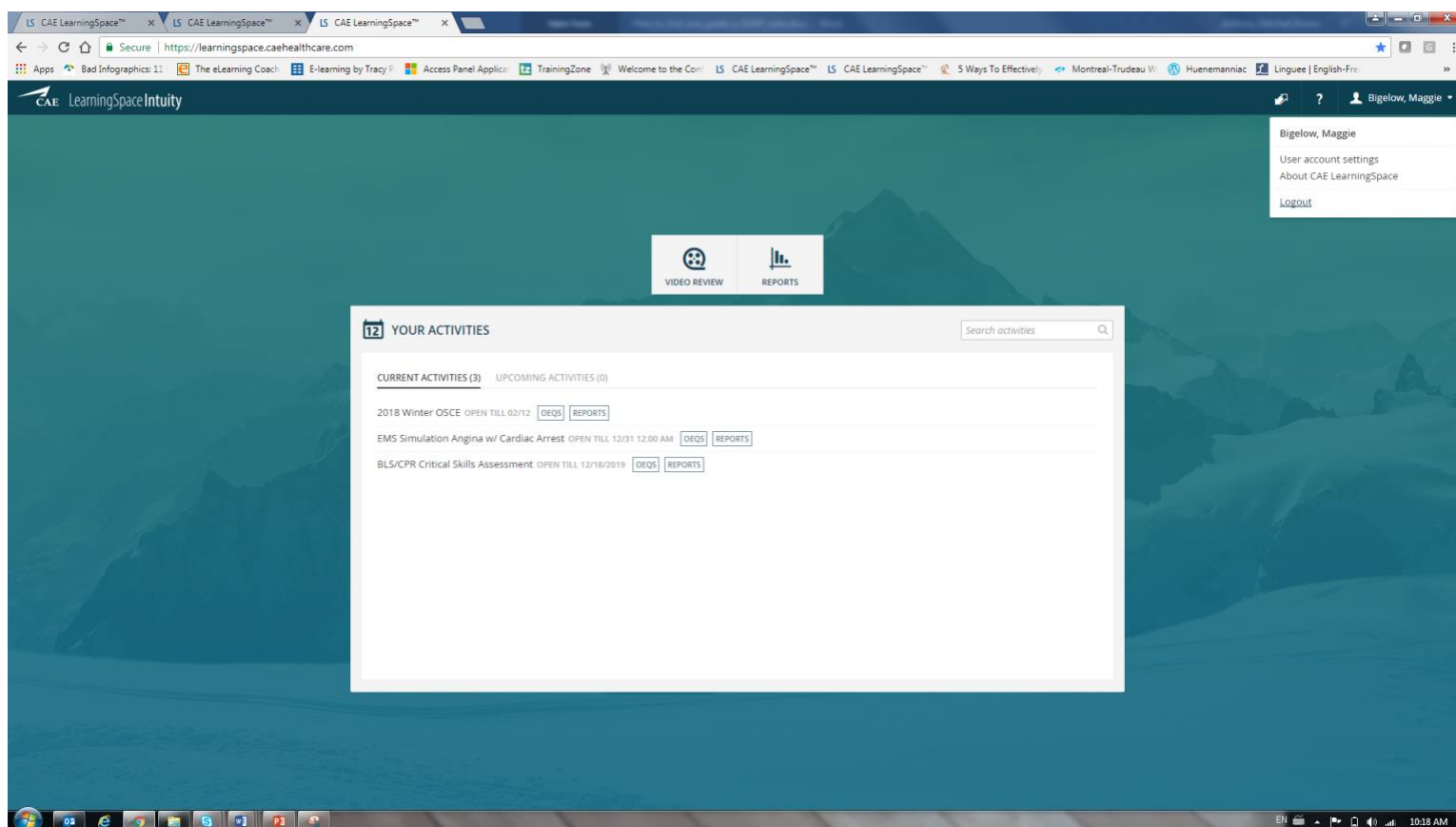
Tip: Help! I Clicked the X! Where's my video?



In the example above, the user closed window #2. If this happens to you, don't panic! It's easy to restore the window.

1. Click the visibility controls in the upper right corner of the screen (see **red** arrow).
The Visibility Control panel opens.
2. Find the name of the missing window (it is greyed out).
3. Click or tap the greyed out name to restore the window.

Log Out of LearningSpace



To log out of LearningSpace:

1. Click your name in the upper right corner of the screen.
The Account Settings box opens.
2. Click **Logout**.
LearningSpace logs you out.

If using Simulation Center computers complete the following additional steps:

1. Close the browser
2. Click the windows box in the bottom left corner of the screen

3. Select the “Power” icon  at the bottom of the list
Select **Shut down**
