

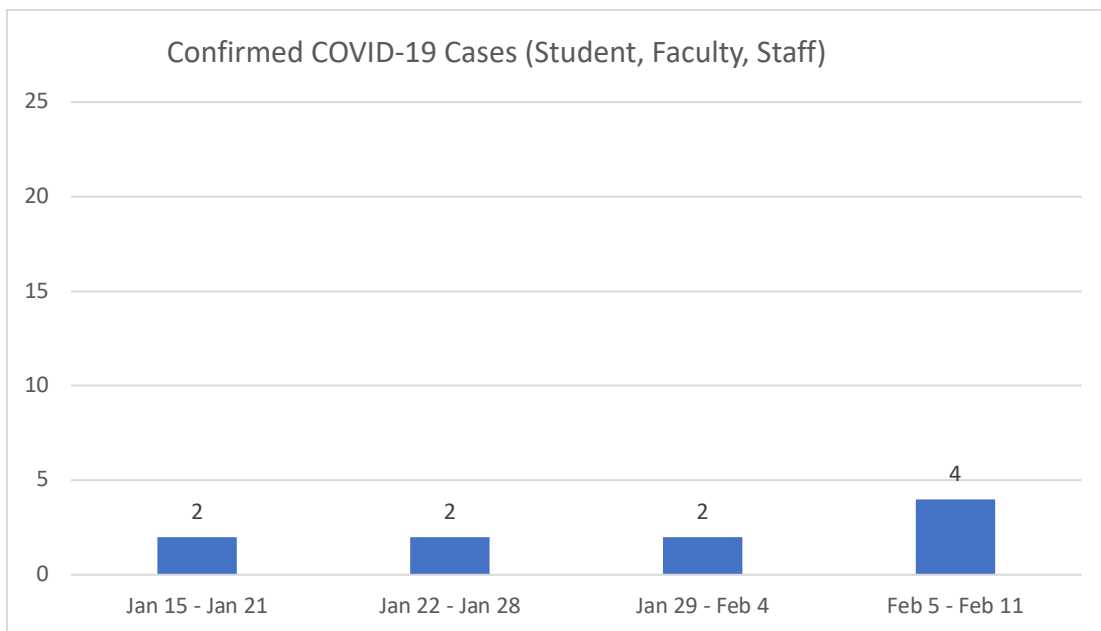
Confirmed Cases of COVID-19

Des Moines University (DMU) has been tracking reports from students and employees of potential COVID-19 exposures since March 2020. The first confirmed case of COVID-19 was reported to DMU in May 2020.

DMU is reporting positive COVID-19 cases in an effort to provide useful data for our campus community. We will update positive cases reported in our campus community every Wednesday afternoon for the preceding week and four-week periods.

Data displayed include positive COVID-19 cases reported by members of the DMU community (students, faculty and staff), including students on rotation at off-campus and out-of-state rotations. Due to the timing of testing and receipt of test results, weekly totals are subject to change.
